PREPARATION PROGRAM for

OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH

The Out-of-School Youth GED Preparation Program has been developed with the cooperation of the Jersey City & Hudson County One Stops, and the Hudson County GED Testing Center located at Hudson County Schools of Technology. The program is specifically designed to motivate and teach students who have traditionally not done well in classroom settings. The program is created by developing individualized learning plans for each student which will take into account the difficulties a high school dropout faces to develop an innovative educational experience, which makes everyone successful. The program utilizes four methods of instruction for the five subject areas of the GED exam. The four methods of instruction are small group lessons, one on one tutoring, online instruction and independent study.

The Jersey City Employment & Training Program and the Hudson County Career Development Center will certify all candidates who meet the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) requirements.

Students will be placed in the GED preparation program.

Upon completing and passing the GED exam, students will be counseled by a career counselor from either the Jersey City Employment & Training Program or the Hudson County Career Development Center to be placed in a post secondary training program.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE IF:

- You are at least 16 to 21 years old (parent/guardian must accompany 16/17 years old to complete a Consent to Participate form; guardians must bring court documents awarding guardianship)
- You didn't complete or don't have a high school diploma
- You are a resident of NJ
- Meet the WIA requirements
- Take an Online TABE Test

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO REGISTER:

Must bring the following documents:

- 1. Proof of residency: Must be a resident of NJ (current PSE&G bill, phone bill, or rent receipt)
- 2. Identification: ID, Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Alien Registration Card
- 3. Proof of Income: Last three pay stubs or legal guardian's paystubs or source of income, and last year's income tax return or family first card
- 4. Release Form: An official letter from the last school you attended stating that you are no longer enrolled in school
